QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION:

ANSWER KEY

It means to help someone.

In the story, Leo asks this because he wants to help his mom with the gardening and planting flowers

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION:

3- Details and Observation: Describe the "unusual" way Grandpa is fishing. Where is he sitting and what is he using as a lake?

ANSWER KEY

Grandpa is sitting in a comfortable chair in the yard.

Instead of a lake, he is fishing in a small, blue plastic pool.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION:

4- Critical Thinking: Why does Leo call this Saturday "happy and unusual" at the end of the story?

ANSWER KEY

It is unusual because every family member is doing something different from their normal routine.

It is happy because the family is together, getting along well, and enjoying a surprise picnic.
