Robots That Look Like Us

We usually think robots are big machines in factories. But today, some robots look like people. These are called "humanoid robots." They have a head, two arms, and two legs. Some even have a face with eyes and a mouth.



Engineers make these robots to help us. A humanoid robot can do boring or dangerous jobs. For example, they can carry heavy boxes or clean big buildings. In Japan, some robots work in hotels. They can greet guests and answer simple questions.

Some new robots are very smart. They can walk, run, and even dance. They use cameras in their eyes to "see" the world. They have big batteries, so they need to charge, just like a mobile phone.

However, humanoid robots are not perfect. They cannot feel emotions like love or sadness. They only do what computers tell them to do. But in the future, many scientists think we will have robot helpers in our homes.

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Teacher's Notes

Preparation: Print one copy of the worksheet per student.

Warm-up: Ask students: "Do you have a robot at home? (like a vacuum cleaner)" and "Do you want a robot friend?" Write the word Humanoid on the board and explain it means "looks like a human."

Procedure:

1. Read the title and look at any pictures. Predict what the robots can do.
2. Students read the text silently.
3. Read the text aloud as a class to check pronunciation of words like "battery," "heavy," and "emotions."
4. Students complete the exercises.

Follow-up: Ask students to draw their own robot and write 3 things it can do (e.g., "My robot can cook pizza.").
